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Approach	Goal	Example
Research	Generate new knowledge	Study the effectiveness of a different dosing schedule for pain medication
Quality Improvement	Improve patient care	Implement a new pain assessment tool across surgical departments
Service Evaluation	Assess how well care is working for patients	Ask patients to complete a questionnaire about their pain management after surgery
Clinical Audit	Assess whether care is meeting benchmarks	Compare analgesic prescribing against national guidelines

Research

- Goal is to create new knowledge
- Applies beyond a single setting
- Highest risk
- Most resource and time intensive

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Quality Improvement

- Aim is to improve practice
- Don't need ethical approval
- Context specific



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Service Evaluation

- How well is care working for patients?
- "Friends and family test"
- Identify strengths and areas for improvement
- Context dependent, within organization
